#### **Corinthia Hotels new partnership to launch Corinthia in Chengdu**

International Hotel Investments p.l.c. (IHI) has announced that its subsidiary, Corinthia Hotels Limited (CHL), has entered into a partnership with *ShiLong Industry Co* and *The Geminus Group* of London to operate a landmark hotel property under development in Chengdu, China. Chengdu is the capital city of the Chinese province of Sichuan and has a population of 21 million. In 2011, it was recognized by UNESCO as a city of gastronomy. It is associated with the giant panda, a Chinese national symbol that inhabits the area of Sichuan.

The hotel will be named Corinthia Chengdu and is scheduled to open in 2032. The Corinthia brand will be joining other international brands in the city, including Raffles, Ritz Carlton, St. Regis, Shangri-La and Waldorf Astoria

Corinthia Chengdu, along with its branded Corinthia residences, will occupy a new 225m mixed-use tower in the city's Gaoxin District, within the high-tech South Central Activity Zone. The hotel will feature approximately 150 guestrooms and suites, complemented by 60 branded residences, all offering sweeping panoramic views across the city.

This agreement marks a defining moment in Corinthia's continued expansion. Corinthia Chengdu will embody the brand's pioneering grand boutique ethos, blending scale and innovation with the intimacy, craftsmanship and personalised service. It aims to build a destination that captures the local spirit while maintaining its brand's signature character and service.

Corinthia continues to explore additional opportunities across China and the Far East, as part of the Group's phased expansion strategy, underscoring the group's long-term commitment to the market.
